To register please complete the following:

- STEP 1: Team Information & Application** - Include your team name, the manager's name address, phone number(s), and desired division.

- STEP 2: Manager/Coach Contract** - Each manager or coach must complete the contract with a signature, printed name, and date signed.

- STEP 3: Roster** - The roster must be completed legibly. A maximum of fourteen (14) players can be carried on a roster. A minimum of six (6) players must be included on the roster at the time of registration. Roster additions will need to be submitted to the office 3 hours prior to your game. Rosters are frozen after the 3rd league game. All players must sign the Team/Waiver prior to participating in a league game.

- STEP 4: Pay the team fee** - Only checks or credit cards will be accepted for payment of league fees. Checks should be made payable to the "City of Escondido." 50% of the league fee is due by your first league game. Full payment must be complete by your second league game or you will begin to forfeit games.

Game Days: Divisions will be assigned two game days, a "primary" and "alternate". The league will try to schedule most or all of the games on the "primary" days, time permitting. However, teams **MUST** be available to play on both of these days. It is possible teams will have regularly scheduled games on both the "primary" and "alternate" game days. Our current alternate day for all divisions is Monday.

I agree to indemnify, defend, hold harmless and release the City of Escondido, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all lawsuits, damages, claims, judgments, loss, liability, or expenses arising out of (1) any death or personal injuries or property damage that I or my team members may sustain while using property or equipment owned by or under the control of the City of Escondido, or while participating in any activity sponsored by the City of Escondido, or (2) any death or injury which results or increases by any action taken to medically treat me. All of the terms above shall apply whether or not the alleged injury is caused by or arises out of any dangerous condition of property, or the alleged negligence or any acts or omissions of the City, its officers, agents, or employees.

3. Not participate in, or instigate my players to partake in, acts of or threats of physical violence towards referees, teammates, opposing players, parents or staff, under any circumstances.
4. Refrain from objectionable demonstrations or any other forceful action.
5. Abide by and accept all decisions of the referee and staff, whether or not I feel there is any real or imaginary wrong decision or judgment made.
6. Not instruct my players to engage in unnecessary "rough tactics" against opposing players.
7. Not recruit or allow my coaching assistant(s), players or parents to recruit opposing ESC players.
8. Abide by the drug-free, alcohol-free and tobacco-free environment at the ESC.
9. Abide by the Escondido Sports Center league rules and regulations.

I UNDERSTAND THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE ABOVE WILL RESULT IN:

1. Written or verbal warning, OR
2. Removal from current game or next game scheduled, OR
3. Suspension for the remainder of the season, OR
4. Suspension for one year, OR
5. Suspension indefinitely, pending review.
6. Team dismissal from the league and forfeiture of all league fees.

Escondido Sports Center Liability Waiver and Conduct Agreement

Liability Waiver

I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the City of Escondido, its officers, agents, and employees from any and all loss, damage, liability, cost, or expenses arising out of or resulting from the use of equipment or property owned by or under the control of the City of Escondido whether or not that liability, loss, or damage is caused by or arises out of any act or omissions of the City of Escondido, its officers, agents, or employees.

I also understand that the City of Escondido does not carry insurance to cover participants in the activities in which I, my child, or my ward is participating. I understand there are risks associated with these activities, and I assume the risk of any injuries that I, my child, or my ward may sustain during any of the activities. I forever discharge the City of Escondido, its officers, agents, and employees from any lawsuits, damages, claims, or judgments resulting from any personal injuries or property damages that I, my child, or my ward may sustain while using City property or equipment, or while participating in an activity sponsored by the City of Escondido.

Multimedia Release

I understand that the City may take photographs/videos for the use in City publications, Web sites, and news releases without my written consent.

Consent for Emergency Treatment

In the event of sudden illness, accident, or injury which may occur while I am engaged in an activity supervised by City of Escondido employees, I hereby give my consent for emergency treatment as shall be necessary under the circumstances by any physician licensed under the laws of the State of California.

Assumption of Risk of Participation

Player & Manager Code of Conduct

Players and managers at the Escondido Sports Center and adjacent parking lot will always abide by the following code of conduct:

1. Refrain from the use of profane, vulgar, and foul language at any time in the course of league business or activities;
2. Refrain from any abusive verbal attacks, disparaging remarks or dialogue with or about staff, referees, teammates, managers, opponents, and spectators;
3. Not participate in, or instigate teammates to partake in, acts or threats of physical violence towards referees, teammates, opposing players, spectators, or staff under any circumstances;
4. The designated team manager should be the only individual who communicates with game officials on points of rule;
5. Abide by and accept all decisions of the referee and staff; and
6. Not instruct players to engage in “rough tactics” against opposing players.

Failure to observe this Player and Manager Code of Conduct will result in suspension.

Escondido Sports Center Code of Conduct

All individuals are expected to abide by the Escondido Sports Center Code of Conduct displayed throughout the facility. Those who engage in behavior contrary to the posted conduct may lose their privileges and be asked to leave the ESC. Any person who has been asked to leave the premises shall not re-enter the Sports Center for a period of seventy-two (72) hours. (Escondido Municipal Code Section 18-70.)
