


# Super Tots "At-Home-Work"



Hi everyone! This week our theme is Dinosaurs. **Dinosaurs** were huge animals that roamed the Earth thousands of years ago. They went **EXTINCT** long before people lived here, but we learned about them by finding their bones, (fossils) and putting the skeletons together, kind of like a puzzle.

<p><b>*Letter X</b> -Flour writing Put some flour on a cookie sheet &amp; have kids practice writing their letters.
