- Priority for court use is limited to the following activities on these days/times:

- When players are waiting, court use shall be limited to a maximum of two (2) hours.
- The use of the court is limited to the sport(s) the court is striped for.
- All players must wear non-marking shoes.
- Only water is allowed on the courts. Please leave food or drink outside.
- Groups may reserve court space through Escondido Community Services for a fee. Reservations and activities must adhere to the priority use schedule stated above. To make a reservation call 760-839-4691

Court Etiquette

When players are waiting, play shall turn to an open play format wherein:

- Players shall establish a line with their paddles or racquets.
- Game play will be first to 11 points for pickleball, or one set for tennis.
- Losing team moves off the court, winners stay on. Winners rotate off after two wins.
- One competitive challenge court may be established during each open play session. On these courts, Winners stay on until beaten.
