

WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE THE CITY TO CONSIDER WHEN ANALYZING THESE IMPACTS?

Environmental Topic	What Will be Evaluated
Population & Housing	Analyze how the proposed project may induce substantial population growth either directly or indirectly
Public Services	Analyze how the proposed project may impact the delivery of services such as public schools, parks and recreation, fire and police
Recreation	Analyze how the proposed project may impact existing parks and recreational facilities
Transportation/Traffic	Analyze how the proposed project may affect local vehicular traffic in relation to the existing traffic load and capacity of the street system
Utilities and Service Systems	Analyze how the proposed project may impact issues associated with stormwater drainage, water supply, wastewater treatment, and landfill capacity services during both construction and operations phases
Mandatory Findings of Significance/Cumulative Impacts	Analyze the proposed project when combined with the effects of other past, current and probable future projects
Aesthetics	Analyze key visual resources in the project area, and to determine the degree of visual impact that would be attributable to a proposed project. Further, the analysis should identify key visual resources that warrant consideration in subsequent plans, so as to ensure, where possible, that the integrity of the landscape and built environment is maintained
Tribal Cultural Resources	Analyze the potential of Native American sacred sites located within the proposed project area
Cultural Resources	Analyze the potential for the project to adversely affect paleontological, archaeological, and historical resources. The resources of concern include, but are not limited to fossils, prehistoric and historic artifacts, burials, sites of religious or cultural significance to Native American groups, and historic structures
